

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FOOD SHOPPING, TROOP 727 CAMPOUT

You have been given the responsibility by your patrol to shop for the food that your patrol will share on the next campout.

You have a food budget of \$12.00 per scout that will attend. The troop will reimburse you for the total cost of the food you purchase, up to the budget of \$12.00 per scout. If you see that the food requested will exceed your budget, you are free to change the menu to stay within your budget. For example, if your patrol planned menu calls for steak, you could change to hamburger to stay within budget. Keep in mind that in many cases, the raw vegetables from the produce section of the store costs less than a similar frozen or canned vegetable.

You have _____ scouts that will attend.

You must purchase food for Saturday: breakfast, lunch, and dinner; and Sunday breakfast.

DO NOT PURCHASE SODA. Do not forget ice to keep the perishables cold and any condiments you may need. Check with the quartermaster if your menu calls for items such as charcoal to cook with—we may have it already. And, each patrol has a ready supply of salt and pepper.
