

# GEAR CHECKLIST

The following is a suggested list for all campers who will be staying the week. Keep in mind that baggage space may be limited when traveling to camp. Your completed medical form **SIGNED BY A DOCTOR OR A LICENSED HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER** and **PARENT** or **GUARDIAN** is required. All medical forms will be available for pick up at the end of your week of camp. The Medical Form and Medication Form are to be given to the Scoutmaster/Adult Leader before leaving for camp. Your swimming trunks and a beach towel should be at the top of your duffel bag/backpack to make easier to change for the swim check.

**Required Forms:**

- Clothes necessary for clothes inflation if working on swimming or lifesaving merit badge
  - Long regular pants
  - Long-sleeve, button down shirt
  - Belt
  - Socks
  - Shoes that can get wet

- Mess kit for patrol cooking
- Drinking cup
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Canteen or water bottle

- Sunscreen

- Laundry bag

- Pump Style Insect Repellent (non aerosol)
- Medication in original bottle

- Alarm clock that uses batteries
