

Troop 727 Campership Guidelines

*Camperships are grants of financial assistance provided to Scouting families in need.
Assistance may be available from Dan Beard Council and/or Troop 727.*

- A Scout must use any funds in his Troop Scout account first.
- If you are requesting financial assistance for a District or Council event, you must first request assistance from the Dan Beard Council. Go to danbeard.org for additional information. To request campership application form call Dan Beard Council - Jason Pigg 513-659-9830 or Kyle Acus 513-577-770
- In order to be eligible for Troop 727 campership funds for District or Council events, you must provide the Troop Campership Administrator with written documentation (e.g., an email or letter you received from the Council with their decision). Said documentation is to be submitted with the Troop 727 Request for Financial Assistance form.
- All requests for Troop 727 scholarship funds are submitted by an anonymous process to the Troop 727 Campership Administrator using the Troop 727 Request for Financial Assistance form found on the Troop website (www.bsatroop727.org).

- All District and Council events are eligible (including NYLT).
- All Troop 727 events are eligible.
- Uniforms - Class A shirt, sash, and pants as well as Scout Handbooks are eligible.
 - Scout must check with the Troop's Uniform Exchange first.
- The Troop Committee will consider any campership request only after any identifying information has been removed by Deacon Greg. The Committee will determine the level of assistance to be provided. If the funds are available the Troop Committee will provide a campership of at least 25% of the total cost or the event.
- Unless there is an extraordinary situation the Troop Committee will generally limit campership assistance to a \$150 limit per year per Scout.
- In exchange for financial assistance, the Troop expects 100% participation in all Troop fundraisers for the next calendar year from the date of award of scholarship.
